## **Bus**

**School opens at 8.20 - please do not drop your child to school before then. They will not be allowed inside the building nor will they be supervised.**

## **Pairceáil**

The area in front of the school is a morning drop off only. Please do not leave your car if dropping off there. The car park is strictly for staff only.

## **Lón**

**Déan cinnte go bhfuil forc nó spúnóg ag do pháiste le haghaidh am lóin. Faigheann na páistí an bia te ag 12.30. Ná bíodh lón rómhór aic don chéad sos nó má tá lón acu le haghaidh iar-aire, dean cinnte go bhfuil sé i mbosca difriúil.** Please ensure that the children have a spoon or fork in their lunch box for the hot lunch. They get the hot lunch around 12.30, for the morning break, fruit, yoghurt, or crackers should be enough so that they are ready for their lón te. If they have lón for an after school - please make sure it's in a separate bosca as they tend to eat all at morning break. There is no need to return to the school with lón or drinks - there is filtered water in every classroom.

## **School Payments:**

**Next week we will send out an Aladdin link for the school payments -These do not both need to be paid at the same time, feel free to spread them out over a few months.**

**Two links will be received, one for €50 per child which is to cover Art supplies, Photocopying, ICT subscriptions, Pupil personal accident insurance (24 hours a day cover, 365 days), payments for use of the pitches, buses to certain events and more**

**The other link is for €100 - We ask each family for a single contribution of €100 per year -This can be paid at your convenience. This is vital for every school as it makes up the shortfall between the Department of Education grants and what it actually costs to run a school.**

### Míolta Gruaige:

First week back and we have already been joined by míolta gruaige – head lice. These have no doubt been picked up at camps or on holidays – let's hope they are not shared here. We would ask every family to check and treat their children over the weekend – if everyone does it together, hopefully we can get rid of them for a while!
